

Current Events at the Library - August 8, 2020

The library is OPEN for browsing/checkout and computer use (by reservation only). MASKS ARE MANDATORY.

There is a 30 minute time limit for browsing. A maximum of fifteen patrons is allowed in the library at all times. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the library.

Current hours of operation

Monday – Friday	9 am – 7 pm
Saturday	9 am – 5 pm
Sunday	1 pm – 5 pm

The book drop is open 24/7. All returns may go in the book drop, including media, if it's in a bag. Items are undergoing extensive cleaning before returning to circulation.

Patrons MAY NOT sit or view materials in-house (i.e. magazines or newspapers). Access to the collection is restricted to browsing only to comply with health and safety measures. Patrons may not sit down in the library unless it is to use a public computer.

MASKS ARE MANDATORY. Patrons must wear a mask during their entire visit to the library. Patrons must also practice social distancing with staff and other patrons in the library.

Curbside Service has ended. If you are uncomfortable coming into the library, please give a call from outside (during hours of operation) and we can bring your items out to you!

Computers by reservation: limited to four stations.
